## How to get there

Allow yourself 60 to 90 mins travel time (depending whether you drive like a Formula One tester or Granny-on-a- tractor.)

Leave Cape Town on the N1. At exit 47 (signposted Wellington) take the slip road out & turn right (you will cross back under the N1) This is the R44. Proceed for approx 8 to 9 kms until you come to "Kanonkop" entrance on your left. A landmark will be the turnoff to Elsenberg Agricultural college on the opposite side of the road to Kanonkop. Turn into Kanonkop and after approx 800 metres look for the sign "Simonsberg Christian conference centre" where the road veers to the left

Alternative route:

Drive via the N2 and Baden Powell drive to Stellenbosch. Follow the R44 past Stellenbosch for approx 8 kms. Kanonkop turnoff will be on your right
